SUBJECT: General Order—No Alcohol During Combat Maneuver Training Center (CMTC) Rotations

1. Purpose. This order establishes a clear prohibition of alcohol consumption and related activities by 1st Armored Division soldiers while divisional units are conducting a CMTC rotation. Such a prohibition is necessary to maintain the health, safety, and security of Iron Soldiers, promote good order and discipline, and maximize the value gained from our scarce training opportunities at CMTC.
2. Applicability. This order is applicable to all 1st Armored Division military personnel training in the German state of Bavaria or on temporary duty (TDY) in Bavaria while 1st Armored Divisional elements form the training task force for a CMTC rotation, as that term is defined in USAREUR Regulation 350-50. For the purposes of this general order, a rotation begins on the first day of deployment to Bavaria and continues uninterrupted until the last day of redeployment from Bavaria.
3. Attachments. This order will be applicable to nondivisional units participating in 1st Armored Divisional CMTC rotations upon publication of attachment orders that expressly incorporate this order by reference.
4. Punitive Order. This order is punitive. Persons subject to the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) who violate this order may be punished under Article 92, UCMJ, for violating a lawful general order.
5. Prohibition. This order strictly prohibits the introduction, purchase, possession, use, sale, transfer, manufacture, or consumption of any alcoholic beverage by all 1st Armored Division military personnel throughout Bavaria during every CMTC rotation, whether those personnel are in a military uniform or not, whether they are on or off Hohenfels Training Area (HTA), Grafenwoehr Training Area (GTA), or other military installation or training area in Bavaria, whether they are part of the training task force or not, and regardless of TDY or other duty status. Personnel on authorized leave status in Bavaria during a rotation are not subject to this order. I will be the sole granter of any exceptions or waivers.
6. Duration. This order is effective immediately and remains in effect until rescinded, superseded, or modified.
